- Eligibility: Any sailboat not over 23 feet that regularly sails on Irondequoit Bay.
- Registration: Boats must register at the Newport Yacht Club or the Rochester Canoe Club before 12:30 pm the day of the race.
- Checking In: All participants must hail their sail number to the race committee boat prior to their start.
- Starting Sequence: Horns will be sounded in 5:00 minute intervals. Each flag will be dropped one minute prior to the next signal. If possible, a class flag will be displayed indicating the class that is starting next. All boats are asked to keep clear of the line until their start.

- Course: The course will be a triangle sailed on Irondequoit Bay. The start will be in front of the Newport Yacht Club. A **red** triangle will indicate marks to port, a **green** triangle will indicate marks to starboard. M1 displayed on the side of the boat will indicate 1 time around. M2 will indicate two times around.
- Lifejackets: The “Z” flag may be flown to indicate that all participants must wear an USCG approved PFD while racing. Participants not wearing PFDs will not be eligible for awards.
- Spinnakers: No spinnakers are permitted. Spinnaker poles may be used with jibs.
- Awards: Perpetual jugs and keeper trophies will be awarded at the Newport Yacht Club after the racing. Please join us for free refreshments immediately following the racing.
